II. NUMBER OF YEARS OF FORMAL STUDY OF SPANISH

(Guideline for non-hispanic: consider that formal study of Spanish may have begun in upper division course.)

- 5: 4 or more years
 - 4: 3 years
 - 3: 2 years
 - 2: 1 year
 - 1: no formal study of the language

III. INTEREST IN LANGUAGE, PLANS FOR CONTINUING STUDY:

- 5: Plans to be a teacher of the language, interpreter, or foreign service officer
 - 4: Plans to see language in high use career, such as international business, banking, or travel-related careers, social services and welfare programs
 - 3: Plans to use language in occupation where knowledge of language is useful, such as medicine, law, business, or police work
 - 2: Plans to use language in career where knowledge of language could be of use in certain circumstances
 - 1: Does not know or specify career and possible use of language in the future

- 5: For or more years membership, has held office in local club at least 1 year, has attended Convention at least two years before this year

 - 3: Two years membership, has attended Convention at least once
 - 2: One year membership, has attended Convention at least once
 - 1: One year membership, will be attending first Convention for the first time
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VI. GRADES IN SPANISH CLASSES:

- 5: Alls "A's" in Spanish
 - 4: Mostly "A's" and no more than a few "B's" in Spanish
 - 3: Mostly "B's" and a few "A's" in Spanish
 - 2: Mostly "B's" and a few "C's" in Spanish
 - 1: Mostly "C's"

- 1: Member of one school activity and not very actively involved in the community or church

- 5: SAT 1380 or above, ACT 31 or better
- 4: SAT 1220-1340, ACT 27-30
- 3: SAT 1080-1180, ACT 22-26
- 2: SAT 780-990, ACT 16-21
- 1: Sat 740 or below, ACT 15 or below

X. OVERALL EVALUATION OF APPLICATION: _____

- 5: Application is complete, neat, and instructions have been followed without exception. Letters of recommendation indicate that student is in the top 1% according to characteristics for success.
- 4: Application is complete, neat, and instructions have been followed without exception. Letter or recommendation indicates that student is in the top 10% as per characteristics for success.
- 3: Application is complete and instructions have been followed without exception. Letter of recommendation indicates that student is average.
- 2: Application is complete and instructions have generally been followed. Letters of recommendation indicate that student is average.
- 1: Application is incomplete
